POWDER BROWS

The art of natural eyebrow pigmentation. Phi PowderBrows is an eyebrow shading technique carried out using a permanent makeup machine and pigments to achieve very natural powder and pixel effects. The 1990s trend for thin eyebrow styles has been consigned to history. The current trend favors the exact opposite: back to natural looks – bold, bushy, natural styles create the perfect eyebrow

OMBRE BROWS

While a more pronounced shading technique is used in the lower part and in the outer third of the brow, the line becomes softer and lighter as you move toward the top and the front. This creates a 3D effect, which is also how ombré brows get their name. There are no limits to the unique color gradients that can be created by adjusting the level of shading. On the other hand, those who are looking for a completely natural look can opt for a more natural shading option, which avoids more intensive shading and color gradients in the shading. The best thing about these techniques is that they are particularly well suited to freshening up, improving, covering up, or correcting old, faded, or unsuccessful permanent makeup.

DEFINED BROWS

Defined brows is an eyebrow shading technique that in its way gives perfect definition to the eyebrows in terms of both shape and color. In contrast to the very natural and conventional powder brows techniques, defined brows can be used to create a perfect, more intense brow look. The shape and color of the brows are clearly defined, producing showstopping results with a wow effect. In this technique, finely graduated pigmentation is applied to the base of the brow, allowing you to create a color gradient and the associated ombré effect.

You will also gain insights into topics including: Hygiene, Dermatology, Contraindications, preparation and aftercare, Colors and their effects, use of needles and tools, preparing your workstation and the client, Measuring/golden ratio, drawing the perfect shape, How to use the Phi app (to be able to use the online support to its full extent), Fine-tuning and dotting technique, And much more besides
